Air Canada Announces New Service out of London

London International Airport and Air Canada announced today the launch of new daily Air Canada service between London and Calgary starting June 1, 2009.

Air Canada's service will operate using the Embraer 190 jet aircraft. The Embraer 190 is a modern 93 seat aircraft including 9 executive class seats and individual seat back video that offers passengers exceptional comfort and convenience.
